Linux

On Ubuntu 12 and higher library libwebkitgtk-1.0-0 needs to be installed.

```
sudo apt-get install libwebkitgtk-1.0.0
```

You may need to make the shell scripts executable by using the **chmod** command:

```
cd data-integration
chmod +x *.sh
```

Now we extract the content of the zip file and if we are in

- Windows *run Spoon.bat*
- Linux *run Spoon.sh*
